The Speaker is the presiding officer of the House of Assembly and is elected by all the Members. The Speaker regulates debate according to the rules and practices of the House and casts the deciding vote in the event of a tie. The Speaker is also in charge of the administration of a wide range of programs relating to the Legislature and providing services to the Members of the House.

The Speaker welcomes you to the Nova Scotia House of Assembly and asks you to note the following rules while in the galleries:

You are not to lean over the front rail or place articles on the rail.

You must abstain from applause or making any interruptions or disturbances, expressing approval or disapproval of proceedings.
