## ***Colchester-Musquodoboit Valley***

*Following the recommendations of the 1992 Electoral Boundaries Commission report, the name of Colchester South was changed to Colchester-Musquodoboit Valley. At the same time, the boundaries were redrawn to encompass the Musquodoboit Valley area, formerly part of the Bedford-Musquodoboit Valley district, and the Millbrook Reserve, formerly part of the Truro-Bible Hill district. As well, the Salmon River area was moved out of the district.*

*In 2021, the district gained Meagher's Grant from Eastern Shore and areas from Preston-Dartmouth.*
