An Act to Amend Chapter 36 of the Acts of 2001, the Pharmacy Act

Be it enacted by the Governor and Assembly as follows:

- 1 Chapter 36 of the Acts of 2001, the *Pharmacy Act*, is amended by adding immediately after Section 13 the following Section:
 - 13A Any person may appeal to the Registration Appeals Committee established pursuant to the regulations
 - (a) the decision of the Registrar to refuse to register or license that person; or
 - (b) conditions imposed on a licence by the Registrar.
- 2 Subsection 77(1) of Chapter 36 is amended by adding immediately after clause (u) the following clause:
 - (ua) establishing a Registration Appeals Committee and prescribing the power and procedures of the Committee;
- 3 Subsection 80(2) of Chapter 36 is amended by adding immediately after clause (c) the following clauses:
 - (ca) the authorizing and regulating of pharmacists ordering, receiving, conducting and interpreting tests and services needed to properly manage drug therapy;
 - (cb) the authorizing and regulating of pharmacists directly administering drug therapy to patients;
