An Act to Amend Chapter 31 of the Acts of 2004, the Police Act

Be it enacted by the Governor and Assembly as follows:

- 1 Chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, 1989, the *Police Act*, as amended by Chapter 68 of the Acts of 2010, is further amended by adding immediately after Section 26D the following Section:
 - 26DA(1) The Governor in Council may, on the recommendation of the Director, appoint investigators as necessary for the purpose of the Serious Incident Response Team.
 - (2) The investigators shall be paid such salary and remuneration as the Governor in Council determines.
- 2 Section 26E of Chapter 31 as enacted by Chapter 68 of the Acts of 2010, is amended by striking out "investigators and" in the first line.
- 3 This Act comes into force on such day as the Governor in Council orders and declares by proclamation.
