An Act to Amend Chapter 10 of the Acts of 1994-95, the Workers' Compensation Act, to Extend Pension Entitlement to More Workers' Widows

Be it enacted by the Governor and Assembly as follows:

- 1 This Act may be cited as the *Widows' Pension Act*.
- 2 Section 60A of Chapter 10, as enacted by Chapter 1 of the Acts of 1999 and amended by Chapter 5 of the Acts of 2002, is further amended by adding the following subsections immediately after subsection 60A(3):
 - (3A) An application pursuant to subsection (3) by a dependent spouse whose survivor benefits under the former Act were discontinued on remarriage before April 17, 1985, must be made on or before June 1, 2014.
 - (3B) The Board may extend the deadline referred to in subsection (3A), before or after it expires, if it appears to the Board that there are reasonable grounds for the extension.
- 3 Clause 60A(6)(a) of Chapter 10 of the Acts of 1994-95, as enacted by Chapter 1 of the Acts of 1999, is amended by striking out "January 1, 1999" in the first line and substituting "April 17, 1985".
