## An Act to Amend Chapter 7 of the Acts of 2019, the Nova Scotia Museum Act

Be it enacted by the Governor and Assembly as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of Chapter 7 of the Acts of 2019, the *Nova Scotia Museum Act*, is amended by
  - (a) adding ", Tourism" immediately after "Culture" in the second line of clause (b); and
    - (b) adding ", Tourism" immediately after "Culture" in the first line of clause (e).
- 2 (1) Subsection 5(1) of Chapter 7 is repealed and the following subsection substituted:
  - (1) The Board of Governors consists of
  - (a) at least four and not more than 12 members appointed by the Governor in Council for a term of not more than three years; and
    - (b) the Chair of the Sherbrooke Restoration Commission.
- (2) Subsection 5(2) of Chapter 7 is amended by adding "appointed under clause (1)(a)" immediately after "Board" in the first line.
- (3) Subsection 5(3) of Chapter 7 is amended by adding "appointed under clause (1)(a)" immediately after "Board" in the first line.
- 3 Subsection 5(4) of Chapter 425 of the Revised Statutes, 1989, the *Sherbrooke Restoration Commission Act*, is amended by striking out "Chairman, a Vice-chairman" in the second line and substituting "Chair, a Vice-chair".
