The undersigned has the honour to report for the consideration of the Council the following:

THAT in view of the recent disastrous catastrophe in the City of Halifax it is deemed advisable to make a grant of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to the said City as a contribution from the Province of British Columbia towards the rehabilitation and relief of the citizens affected

and to recommend that a Special Warrant in the said sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for the purpose specified herein, be issued.
