THE HONOURABLE THE PREMIER REPORTS FOR THE INFORMATION OF THE COMMITTEE OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL:

That by the recent disaster at the City of Halifax, Nova Scotia, a considerable portion of said City was destroyed or damaged and a large number of citizens were left homeless and destitute.

The Honourable the Premier further reports that after a careful enquiry into the circumstances of the case, and finding that the Provinces and the Dominion are making grants to relieve the necessities of the persons referred to, now RECOMMENDS that a warrant issue of the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to be used for the relief of such homeless and destitute citizens.

And the Committee of the Executive Council now RECOMMENDS that His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor undertake to enact legislation at the next session of the Legislature ratifying and confirming the provisions of this Order-in-Council.

And His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor approving the said report and several recommendations therein made.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY SO ORDERED.
