Assistance was delivered through an order-in-council on December 18th, 1917. The order stated that, "The sum of \$8,000 was granted by the Council towards the relief of the sufferers of the recent Halifax disaster, payable when required after the 1st day of January 1918. A sum sufficient was also ordered to be paid, when required, towards remunerating the nurses from this Province who went to Halifax to attend to those who were injured in that disaster."

In the minutes from January 29th, 1918, it was stated that \$391.50 had been paid to the nurses (page 127).
