**CHANGES RECOMMENDED TO THE
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE HOUSE ON BILLS
BY THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR
THE OFFICE OF ADDICTIONS AND MENTAL HEALTH**

PAGE 5, Clause 18, proposed subparagraph 39(1)(a)(ii), line 1 - add “the substitute decision-maker has reasonable and probable grounds to believe that” immediately before “following”.

PAGE 5, Clause 18, proposed paragraph 39(1)(b), line 2 - add “the substitute decision-maker has reasonable and probable grounds to believe that” immediately after “unless”.

PAGE 6, Clause 18, proposed subclause 39(3), line 1 - delete “inform the patient” and substitute “ensure that the patient is informed”.
