CHANGES RECOMMENDED TO THE
LAW AMENDMENTS COMMITTEE

PAGE 1, Clause 1, lines 5 and 6 - delete “subsection” and substitute “subsections”.

PAGE 1, Clause 1, proposed subsection (6A) - add “binding” immediately after “the” the first time it appears in the first line.

PAGE 1, Clause 1 - add the following subsection immediately after proposed subsection 45A(6A):

(6B) The House shall, in accordance with the non-binding recommendations to reduce barriers in the report pursuant to subsection (1) following the 2021 general election and dated July 15, 2022,

(a) establish a fund that is accessible to all members who are parents to provide reimbursement for child-care expenses incurred during the business of the House; and

(b) practise nation-to-nation relationship building and consult Mi’kmaq legal scholars to revisit and further the intention pursuant to Section 6 to include as an additional member a person who represents the Mi’kmaq people.

(6B) A child-care fund is established to reimburse members who are parents for child-care expenses incurred during the business of the House pursuant to the reducing barriers recommendation in the report pursuant to subsection (1) following the 2021 general election and dated July 15, 2022.

(6C) The Speaker shall administer the child-care fund established under subsection (6B) and determine the amounts to be paid to eligible members.
