During the meeting, MLA Burrill inquired about the statistics of administrative confinement. In response, I have followed up with colleagues at the Department of Justice and please find below the information we received from Correctional Services:

Statistics for September 1, 2021 to September 1, 2022 are as follows:

- Total Indigenous individuals placed in administrative close confinement - 18
- Percentage of total number of individuals placed in administrative close confinement that were Indigenous - 15.52\%

Reason for administrative close confinement include:

- Security of the facility
- Protection
- Inmate's own request
