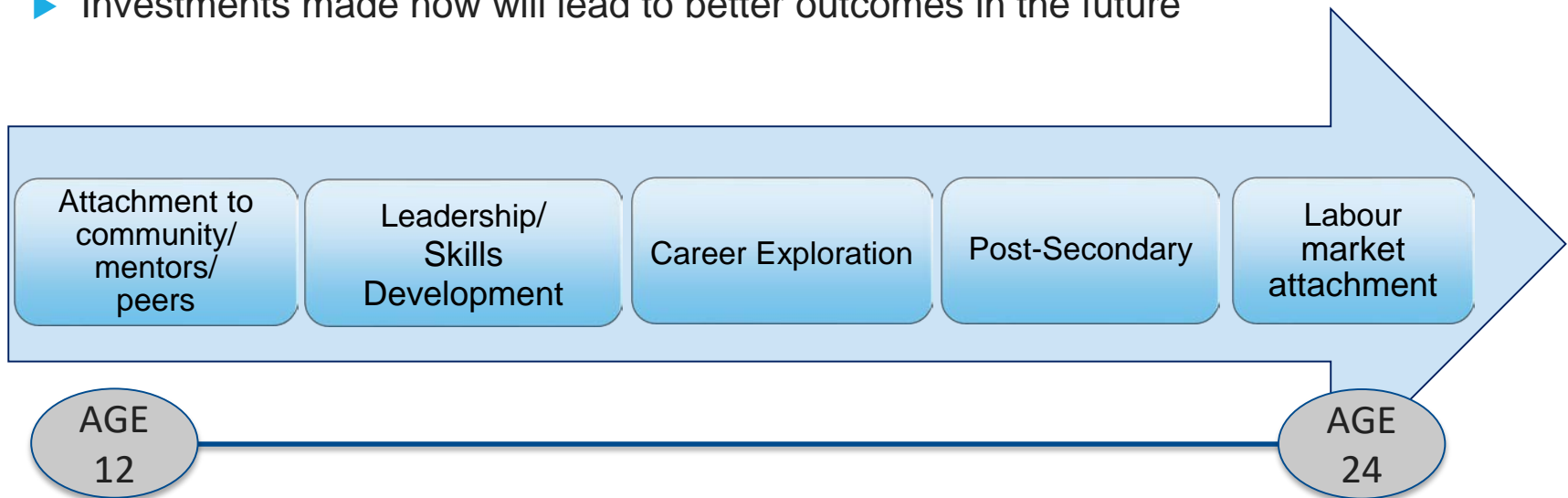

# ESIA TRANSFORMATION

## Career Rising is part of the ESIA Preventive Continuum

- ▶ Committed to expanding and investing in preventive programming for youth at risk
- ▶ Building a continuum of supports for youth so that they can increase their education and employability
- ▶ Investments made now will lead to better outcomes in the future



# CAREER RISING

## Building a Career Path for Youth at Risk

Partnership between Community Services and the Nova Scotia Co-operative Council serving rural Nova Scotian communities and youth.

### Goal

Career Rising supports high school students to gain work experience, develop their career goal and go on to post-secondary education.





# CAREER RISING

## Program Components

1. Two-week skills development camp
2. Paid work experience (subsidy offered)
3. Ongoing workforce and career development supports post work-experience
4. Post-secondary grant of \$1,200 each year completed; one-time contribution of \$500 from the Colchester Cumberland Community Credit Union

# CAREER RISING

## Snapshot of Youth

They are young people motivated to learn, grow, contribute and build their career paths.



- ▶ Referred by DCS, Co-op Council, local organizations, Schools Plus, etc.
- ▶ Youth ages 15-19, and in high school
  - ▶ ESIA clients or dependents
  - ▶ Youth in care
  - ▶ CYFS-funded youth outreach programs
- ▶ Live in or near program sites
  - ▶ Kentville, Bridgewater, Truro, and North Sydney

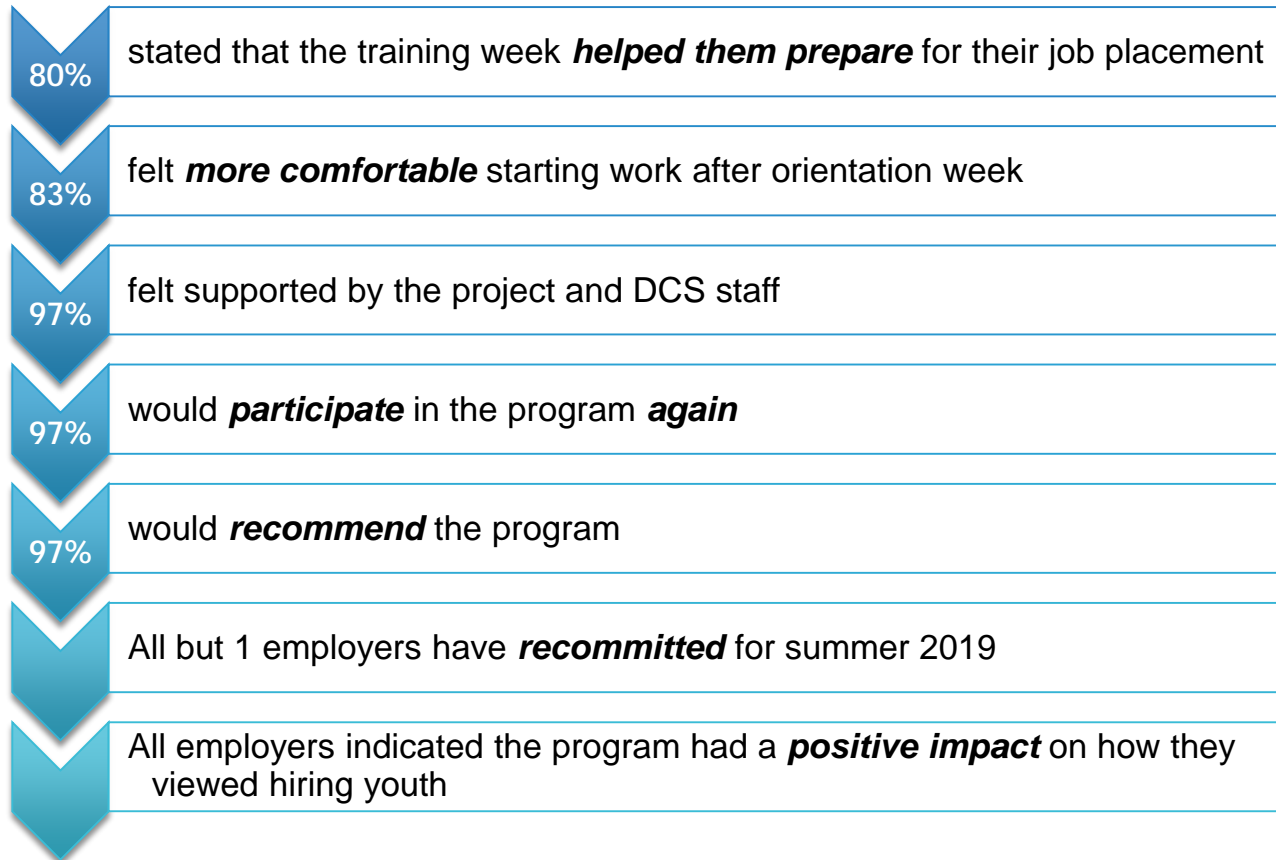


## CAREER RISING 2017 & 2018 Stats

2017	2018
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Kentville, Truro</li> <li>▶ 12 employers</li> <li>▶ 23 youth placed</li> <li>▶ 15 youth completed</li> <li>▶ Average grade: 11</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Kentville, Truro, North Sydney, Bridgewater</li> <li>▶ 40 employers (8 returning)</li> <li>▶ 50 youth placed (4 returning)</li> <li>▶ 30 youth completed</li> <li>▶ Average grade: 10</li> </ul>

# CAREER RISING

## What We Learned – 2018 Participants (Survey)



The **top skills** developed, as reported by participants include: agricultural, working with others/interpersonal, and time management (reliability/dependency)



# CAREER RISING

## Youth Outcomes (2017 & 2018)

Of the **42** youth who have completed the program:

- ▶ **64%** have graduated or are graduating in 2019
- ▶ **33%** youth are still in high school (grade 10/11)
- ▶ **2%** left high school but plan to return

Of the **27** who graduated or are graduating in 2019:

- ▶ **33%** are attending or have enrolled in post-secondary
- ▶ **26%** are working full-time
- ▶ **41%** are solely attending school or looking for employment





# CAREER RISING

## What's Next

Career Rising was recently cited as an example of innovative practice by the **OECD's Observatory of Public Sector Innovation**

In **2019** we are:

- ▶ supporting our first post secondary students sponsored by Inspiring Success and Educate to Work for Dependents
- ▶ Expanding to include referrals from:
  - ▶ New Glasgow, Amherst, Cumberland County, Glace Bay and Sydney
- ▶ Offering a weekend leadership retreat for returning participants
- ▶ Offering new work experiences at local credit unions, and within the fisheries and natural resource sectors

# ESIA TRANSFORMATION

## Continuing to Build Opportunities for Youth

- ▶ **We are just getting started**
- ▶ We continue to evaluate our services and programming to see where we can improve and expand
- ▶ Collaboration with community is key and we will continue to develop those relationships and partnerships so we are able to serve more young people that need us
