ELECTION OF SPEAKER

The Chief Clerk stated that he would now accept nominations for the position of Speaker.

The Hon. The Premier moved the nomination of Cecil Clarke, Member for Cape Breton North, for the Office of Speaker.

The House of Assembly, agreeable to Your Honour's command, has proceeded to the choice of a Speaker and has elected Cecil Clarke, Member for the electoral District of Cape Breton North, to that Office, and by its direction, I present him for the approbation of Your Honour."

After which Her Honour was pleased to say:

"I approve of the Speaker whom the House of Assembly has chosen."

Her Honour was then pleased to retire.

Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair.

The Hon. The Premier then moved that Captain Kenneth Greenham be appointed Sergeant-at-Arms of the House of Assembly.

With the unanimous consent of the House, the motion carried nem con.
