**WHEREAS** we have been advised by Our Executive Council that it is in the public interest that the First Session of the Sixtieth General Assembly should be prorogued this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November, A.D., 2007, and that the Second Session of the Sixtieth General Assembly should meet on Thursday, the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November, A.D., 2007, at two o'clock in the afternoon, for the dispatch of business:

**NOW KNOW YE THAT WE**, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council, have thought fit to prorogue the First Session of the Sixtieth General Assembly on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November, A.D., 2007, and to summon the said General Assembly and do hereby summon the said General Assembly to meet on Thursday, the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November, A.D., 2007, at two o'clock in the afternoon, for the dispatch of business, of which all persons concerned are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
