POINT OF PRIVILEGE

Hon. K. Colwell, Preston, rose on a point of privilege stating he had been assaulted and threatened by the Minister of Economic and Rural Development and Tourism on May 9, 2013 and moved the following Resolution:

“Therefore be it resolved that the member for Waverley-Fall River-Beaver Bank be admonished by the Speaker for threats and intimidation and violating the rights of all members of the House of Assembly, through his actions, and that the matter be referred to the Committee on Internal Affairs and the committee's findings be reported back to the House without delay.”

Hon. Mr. Speaker recessed the House to consult with staff and advised he would report back to the House as early as possible.

SPEAKER'S RULING

“The member for Preston has raised a matter of privilege and contempt.

Members will remember I outlined principles surrounding the finding of a prima facie case of privilege on April 23, 2013.

This is an un-rebutted allegation of assault and of obstruction. According to the authorities this is a matter of contempt and breach of privilege. Following the principles I set out for the House, this constitutes a prima facie case of breach of privilege and of contempt.

I considered the Member for Waverley-Fall River-Beaverbank's resignation from the Executive Council as raised by the Honourable Government House Leader and while it did not go to the question of whether there is a prima facie case it may be something the House may wish to take into consideration.

I have considered the proposed resolution and I understand that the Member for Preston has agreed to restrict the motion to a referral to the Committee on Internal Affairs.

I will now recognize the Member for Preston to read his revised

motion.”

Hon. K. Colwell moved the following motion:

“Therefore be it resolved that the matters related to the actions of the member for Waverley-Fall River-Beaver Bank be referred to the Committee on Internal Affairs and that the committee's finding be reported back to the House without delay.”

The motion carried and the Speaker directed that the matter be referred to the Committee on Internal Affairs.
